1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – JULY 8, 2014

3. FINANCIAL MATTERS

A. NATIONAL GRID INCENTIVE PLAN

A spreadsheet was presented to the Board from Timothy Fitzpatrick showing approximate energy savings of \$166,000 over a one year by utilizing high efficiency bulbs. The Board thanked Mr. Fitzpatrick for his good work.

B. <u>CONCRETE AND MASONRY REPAIRS – REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL ("RFP")</u>

Edward Fahey, Director of Modernization and Procurement, provided the Board with two (2) responses to the RFP for concrete and masonry repairs at multiple MHA properties. Mr. Fahey explained that Tremblay Construction withdrew their bid due to a misunderstanding of the scope of work to be performed. MHA staff recommended to award the bid to Bellrock

Construction, LLC ("Bellrock") in the sum of \$34,450 as being the most responsive and responsible bidder.

After due discussion and upon motion duly made by Joan M. Chiasson and seconded by George N. Bayers, it was unanimously

To approve and authorize the award of the concrete and masonry repairs at multiple MHA properties to Bellrock for the sum of \$34,450 as the most responsive and responsible bidder.
